
The objective of this questionnaire was to get know how our students and their families use water in their everyday life.

The questionnaire:


- was designed by teachers of IES Joaquin Araujo

- was one of the tasks in our Comenius partnership project




Do you have a shower instead of a bath?




Do you turn off the tap while you soap in the shower?




Does it take you more than 5 minutes to have a shower?




Do you turn off the tap while wash you teeth?





Do we save water in our daily routine?





Some bad points:


- most of our students take a shower more than 5 minutes

- they don't reuse the water from shower for washing the floor etc.


Daily Tasks


We have to mention that only 38% of our students save water in their everyday routine. The best results were in Granada 48% and in France 47% The most water wasting students are in Hungary — almost 78% don't save water in their daily tasks.




How much we save water in our household concumption?

















































Household consumption -answers "YES"



Some good points in household concumption:

- most of our families don't turn on their washing machines and dishwashers before they are full,
- most of them make sure the taps are closed properly
- they don't throw things into the toilet
- most of them don't defrost food under the tap

Some bad points:

but they don't use short cycles

most of them leave the tap running waiting for cold or hot water

- In conclusion as we can see from the results of household consumptions they are much better than the results of daily tasks.
- Almost all countries save water as far as household tasks are concerned. Only the students from Lithuania and Hungary waste water a little more.



- We can conclude that although our students are aware of being economical in expenditure of water, we should go on working in this field
- The most important result is that due to this questionnaire our student' awareness of water saving has increased.
