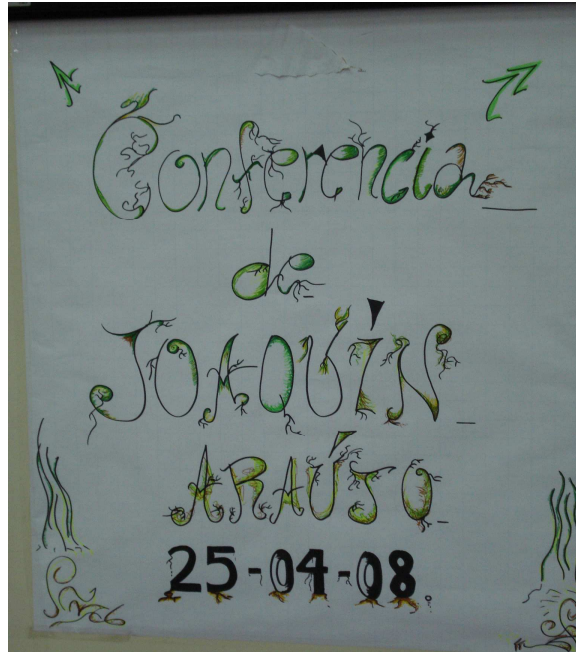

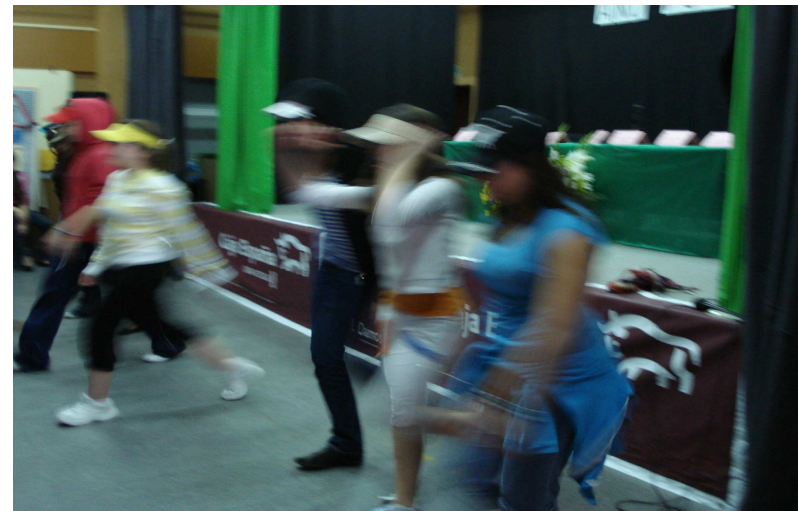

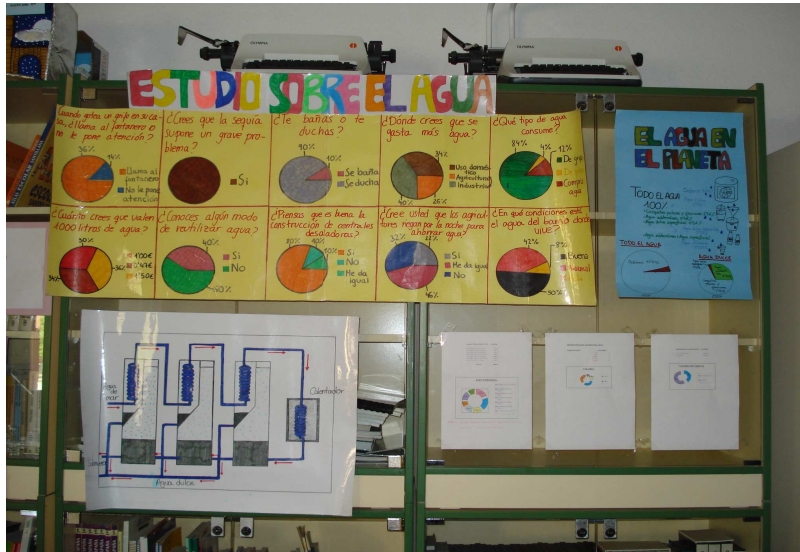






# 1st price of posters contest. Bilingual exhibition in the French Embassy about “Climate change and how to consum for a sustainable development”
