

PRESENTATION: I E S “FRAY LUIS DE GRANADA”



The IES “Fray Luis de Granada” is located in the south of the capital, next to the countryside.

It’s a modern school, founded in the school year 1987/88.

Currently, there are about 500 students, who mainly belong to the middle class, and 47 teachers. We enjoy school transportation which allows us to have students

from different areas of the town and from the metropolitan area.

The building was awarded with the “Premio Nacional de Arquitectura” for its design.



It's comfortable and functional. It has three detached modules with big gardens and areas for various sports.

We have a library



canteen, gymnasium, computer centre,



language laboratory, art studios, music room, technical workshop, staff room etc.



This year we teach 12 groups of Secondary School students, 4 groups of High School students and 1 group of Advanced High School students of Administration and Finance.

Our IES takes part in diverse projects:

- It's a bilingual school Spanish-English
- It has been a Technical Information Centre since the school year 2005/6
- We have some reading projects to broaden our students' interest in reading
- Since the year 2007/8 we have offered extra afternoon classes to help students who have weak marks
- We participate in European projects such as "Comenius" for the exchange of teachers and students with European schools

We have a Department of Orientation which gives advice and orients teachers and head teachers in their daily tasks

The classes are from 8'20 am to 14'25 pm for Secondary School and High School and from 4'30 pm to 22 pm for the courses of Administration and Finances courses.



We carry out numerous complementary activities such as school trips, excursions, sport activities, conferences etc.

There is also a very active parents' association which collaborate in many aspects with the school community.
