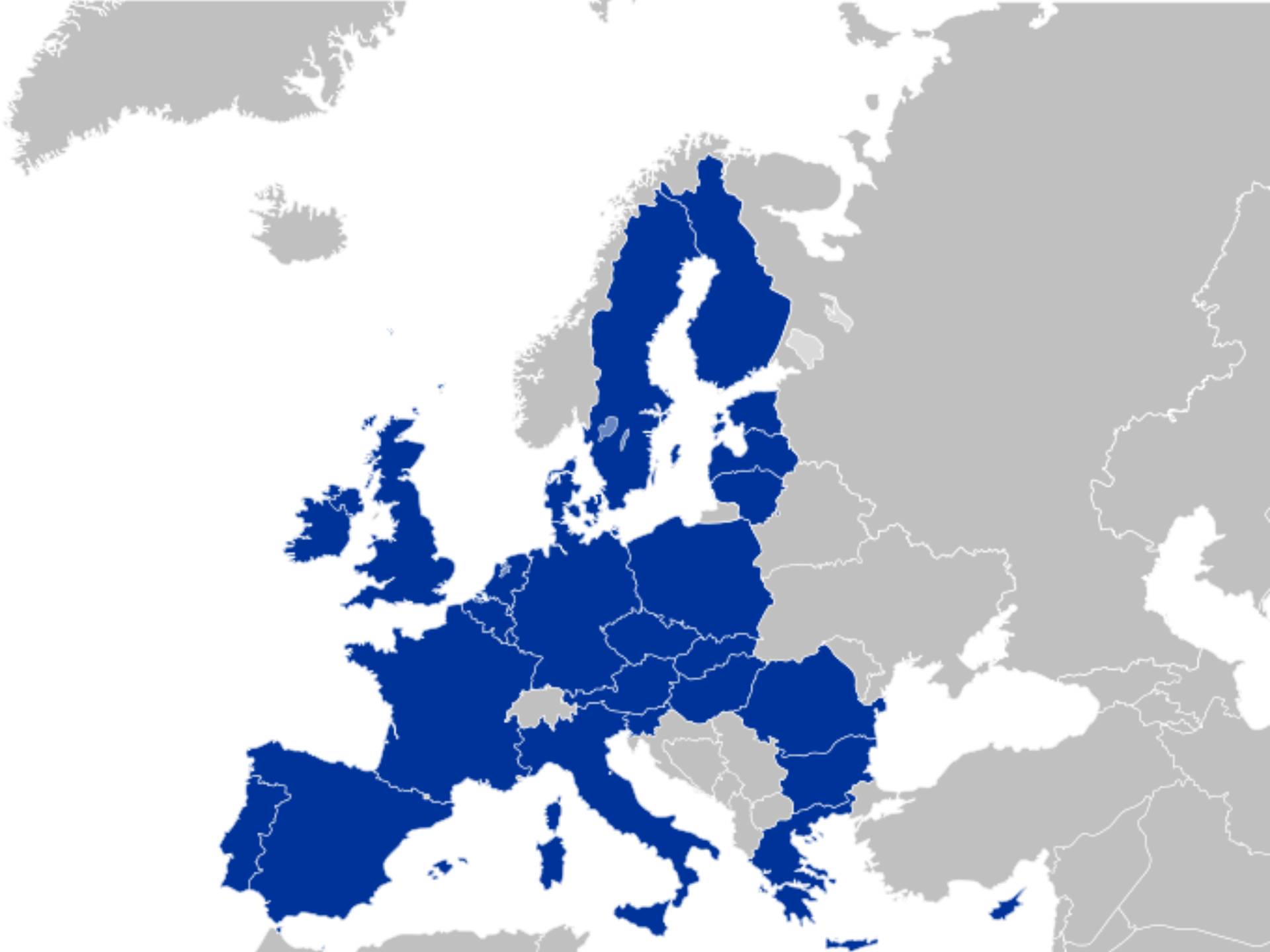

Estonia



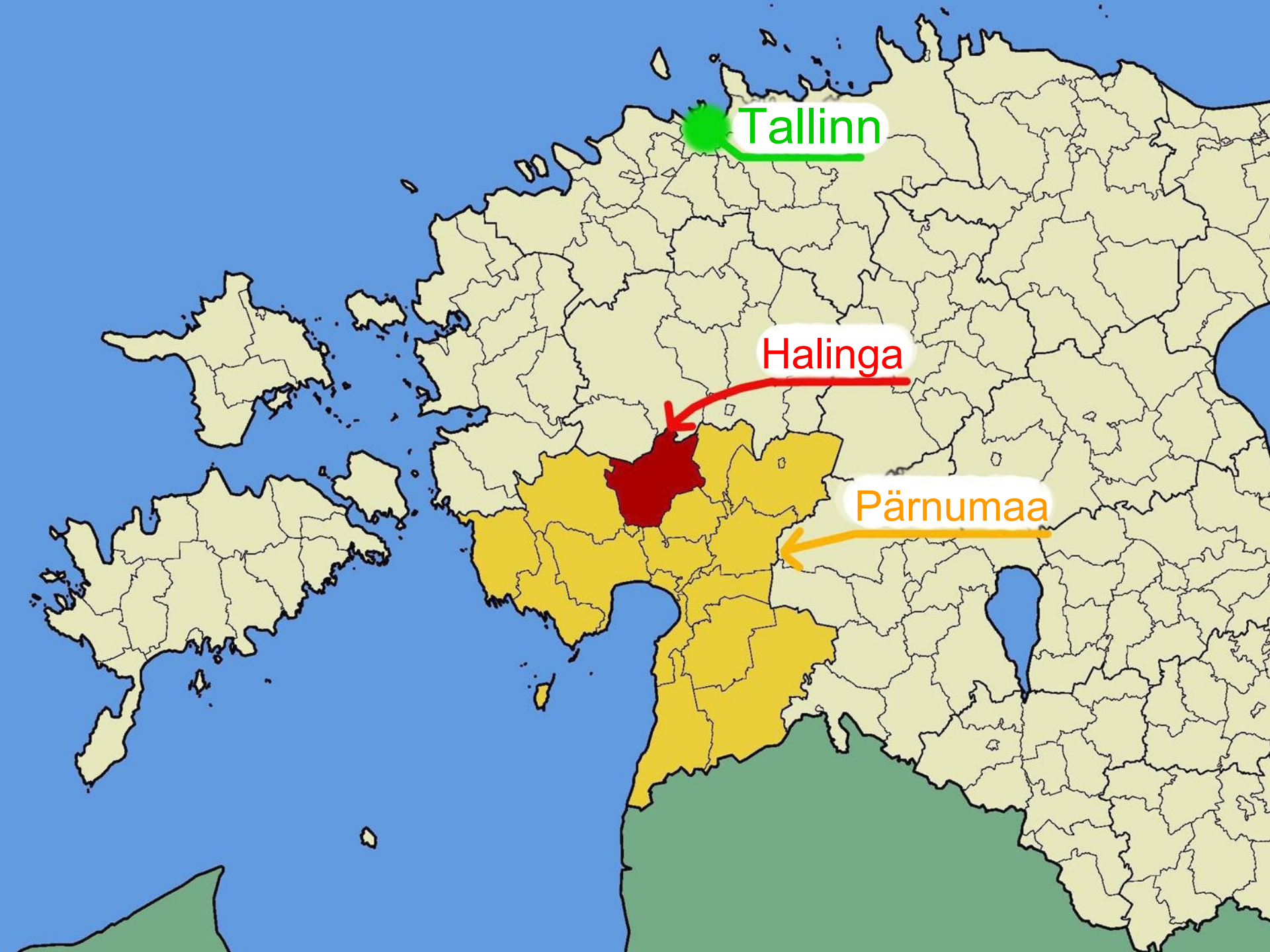


- The First Estonian republic was declared on the 24th February 1918
- Estonia was annexed into the Soviet Union in 1940
- Estonia regained its independence on the 20th August 1991
- Estonia joined the European Union on 1st May 2004

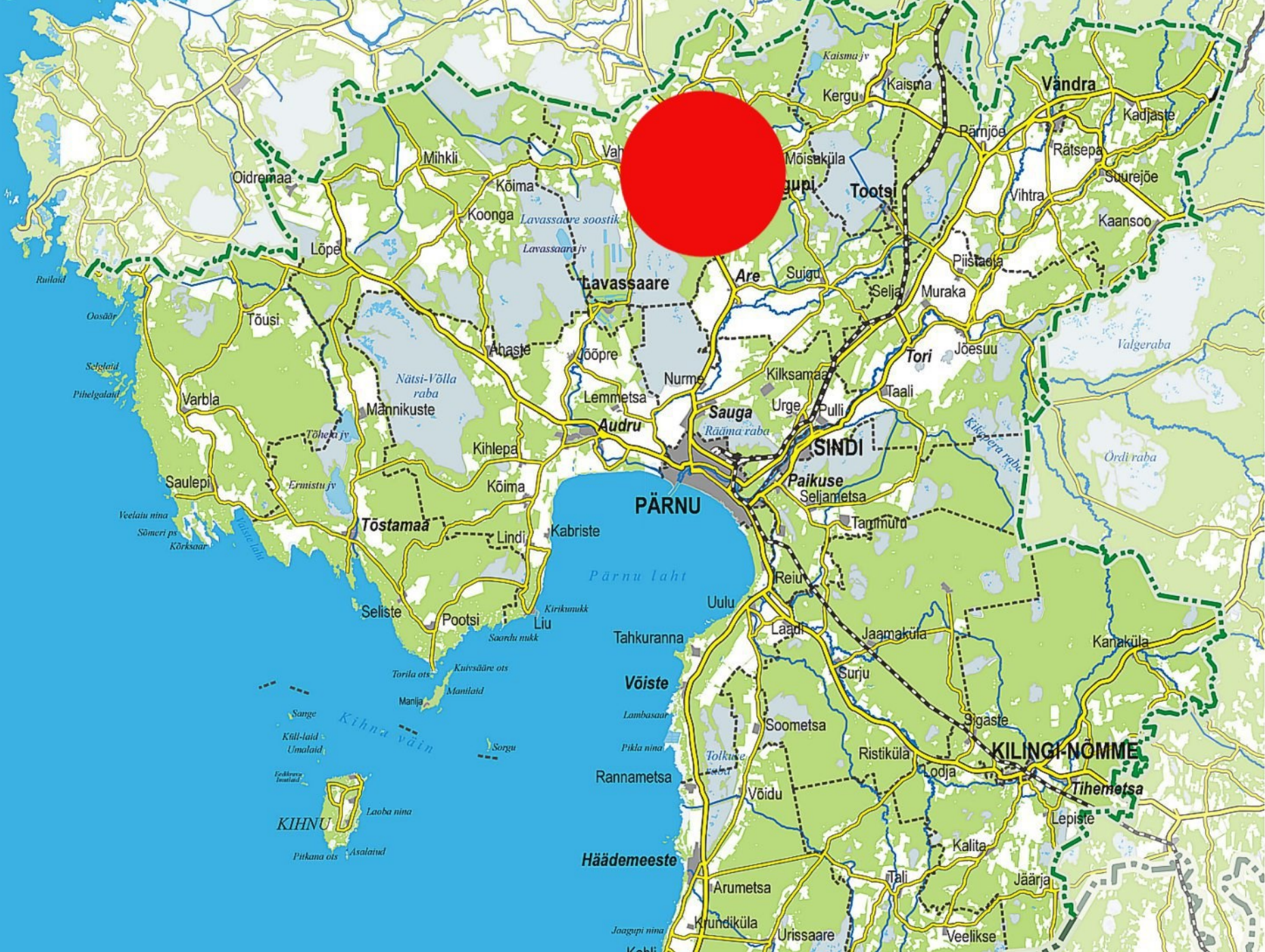
